Neutrality: In order to enjoy the confidence of all, the Movement may not take sides in hostilities or engage in controversies of a political, racial, religious or ideological nature.

Independence: The Movement is independent. The National Societies, while auxiliaries in the humanitarian services of their governments and subject to the laws of their respective

countries, must always maintain their autonomy so that they may be able at all times to act in accordance with the principles of the Movement.

Voluntary service: It is voluntary relief movement not prompted in any manner by desire for gain.

Unity: There can be only one Red Cross or Red Crescent in any one country. It must be open to all. It must carry on its humanitarian work throughout its territory.

Universality: The International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, in which all societies have equal status and share equal responsibilities and duties in helping each other, is worldwide.

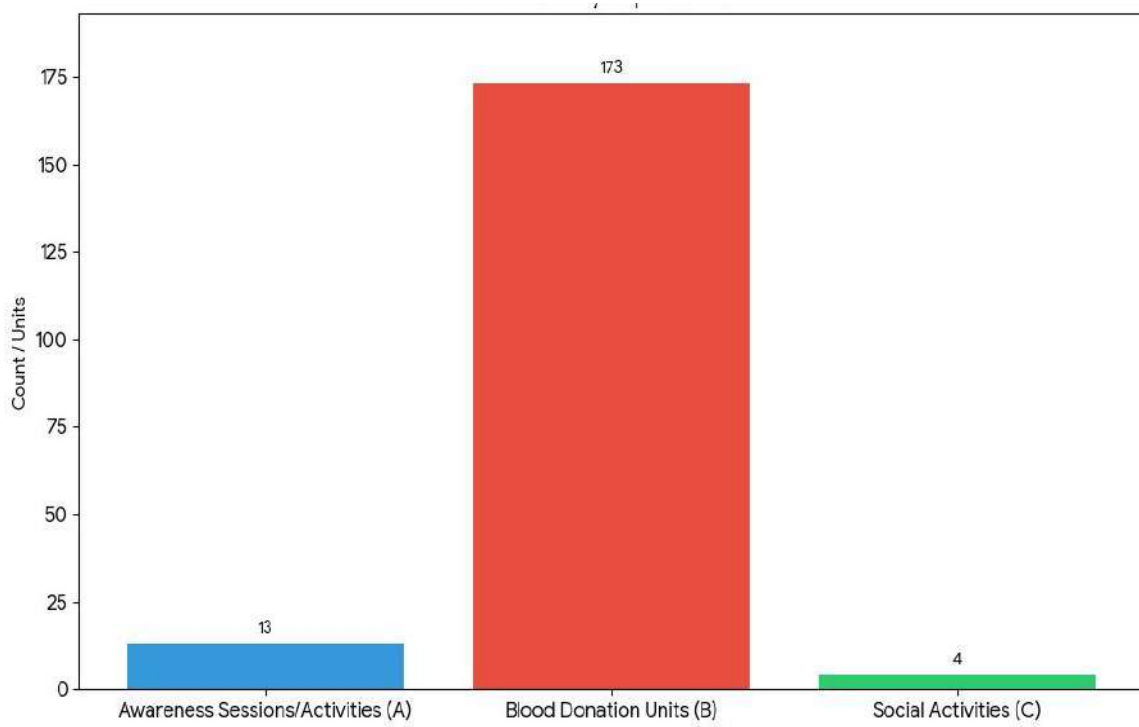

The session was led by **Dr. R. Subramaniyan Raja**, YRC Programme Officer at KPRIET, accompanied by active YRC volunteer **Mr. Roopmann**, a third-year Artificial Intelligence and Data Science student. The session aimed to enlighten newly inducted YRC volunteers of Nirmala College on the vision, mission, and purpose of the Youth Red Cross, as well as to inspire them through real-life examples and field experiences.



Highlights of the Program:

Dr. R. Subramaniyan Raja began the session with a warm address, introducing the legacy of the Indian Red Cross Society and the global Red Cross movement. He emphasized how YRC acts as a bridge between students and society, nurturing compassion, leadership, and civic duty. He also outlined the three fundamental principles of YRC:

- **Protection of health and life**
- **Service to the sick and suffering**
- **Promotion of national and international friendship**

The presentation touched upon a variety of past initiatives undertaken by the YRC unit at KPRIET — from blood donation drives and disaster relief efforts to community development activities and health awareness campaigns. Dr. Raja motivated the students to participate not just as volunteers, but as leaders with empathy.

Adding to the session's impact, Mr. Roopmann V shared his personal journey as a YRC volunteer. His experiences as a student leader, including organizing awareness camps and community outreach, resonated strongly with the audience. He encouraged peers to take initiative, think innovatively, and develop leadership skills while serving society. His enthusiastic delivery and first-hand stories of fieldwork added authenticity and inspiration to the orientation.

A special emphasis was given to the Seven Fundamental Principles of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, which guide all YRC activities globally:

Humanity – Serving people in need without discrimination.

Impartiality – No discrimination based on nationality, race, religion, or political beliefs.

Neutrality – The movement does not take sides in hostilities or controversies.

Independence – YRC remains autonomous while cooperating with governments and institutions.

Voluntary Service – It is a voluntary relief movement not prompted by any desire for gain.

Unity – Only one Red Cross or Red Crescent society exists in one country, open to all.

Universality – All societies have equal status and share equal responsibilities and duties in helping each other.

These principles were discussed in depth, supported with examples from YRC-led initiatives at KPRIET and across the region.

Outcomes and Feedback:

The program was interactive and well-received by the students of Nirmala College for Women. Many participants expressed a keen interest in engaging in future YRC activities and appreciated the collaborative effort between institutions.

The session not only introduced the structural and operational aspects of YRC but also emphasized its emotional and humanitarian core — serving with heart and leading with purpose. It strengthened inter-institutional bonds and highlighted the shared vision of creating a compassionate and socially responsible generation.

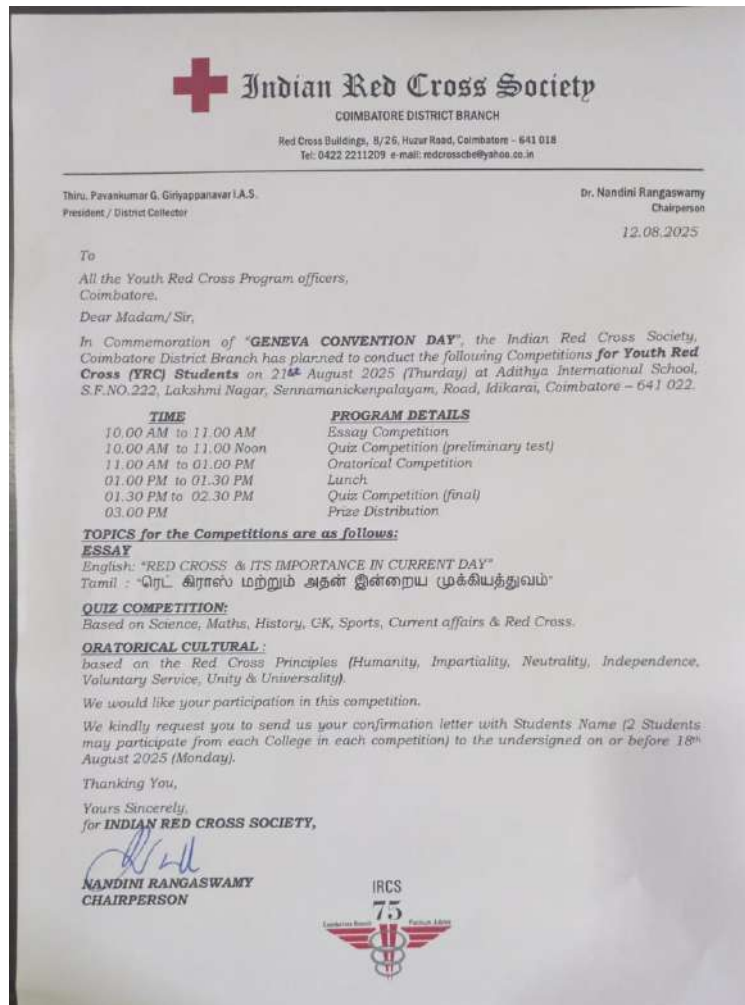

The Youth Red Cross (YRC) of KPR Institute of Engineering and Technology (KPRIET) successfully organized a Massive Blood Donation Camp on 26th September 2025, marking another milestone in its continuous journey of serving humanity and promoting the spirit of volunteerism among students. The camp was conducted under the guidance of Dr. R. Subramanian (Raja), YRC Programme Officer, whose dedicated leadership has consistently inspired students to contribute actively to community welfare.

The event was inaugurated with great enthusiasm in the presence of faculty members and YRC volunteers. The inaugural address highlighted the importance of blood donation as a life-saving act that strengthens the bond of humanity and instills compassion among youth. The Programme Officer motivated students by emphasizing that “every drop of blood donated is a step toward saving a precious life.”

The camp witnessed an overwhelming participation of students, faculty, and non-teaching staff, reflecting the strong humanitarian spirit nurtured within the institution. A team of medical professionals and technicians from KMCH Hospital Blood Bank, Coimbatore, partnered in organizing the collection, ensuring safety and proper medical supervision throughout the process.

A total of over 150 units of blood were successfully collected during the camp, making it one of the largest blood donation drives conducted by YRC–KPRIET to date. Each donor underwent a basic health screening before donation, and medical staff guided them through the process with care and encouragement. 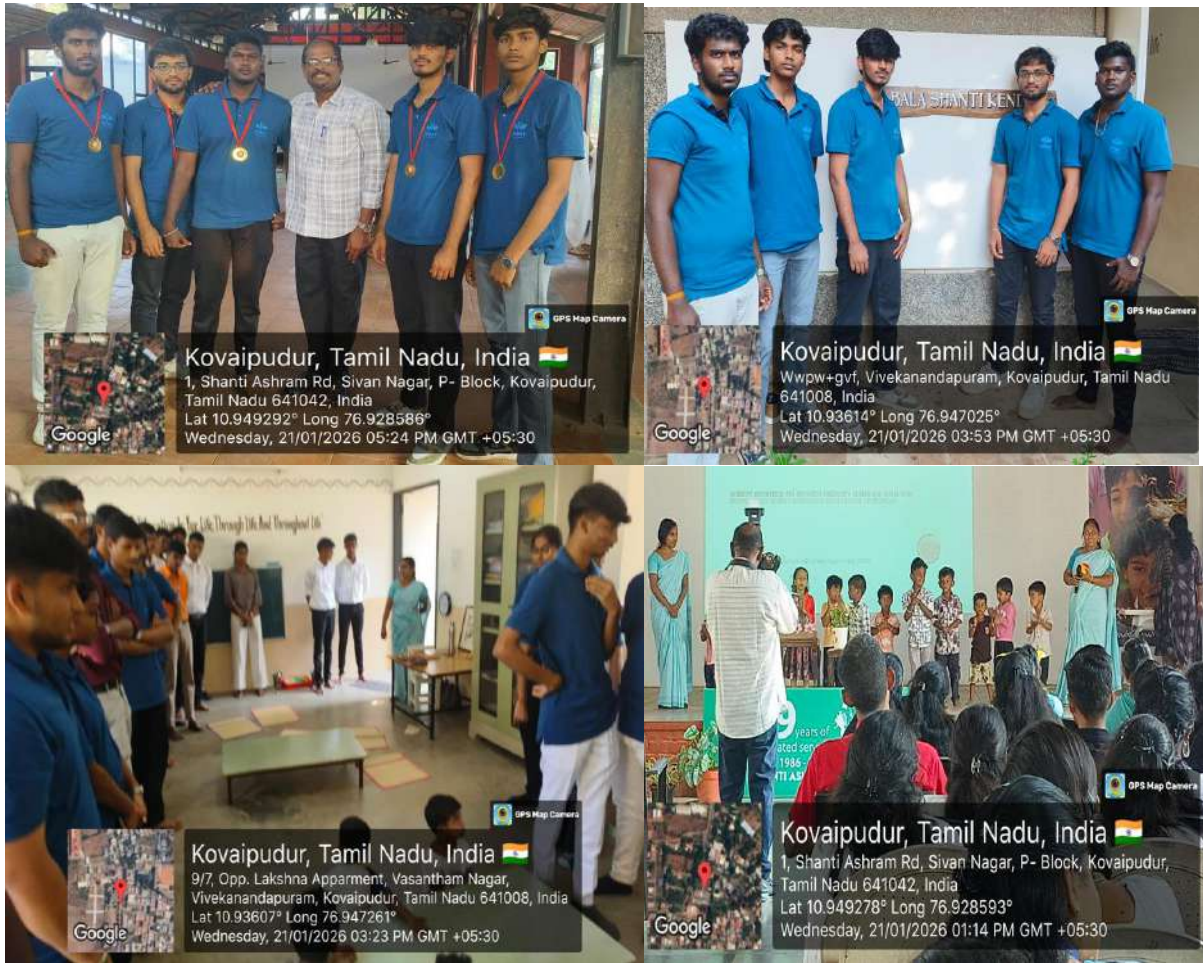

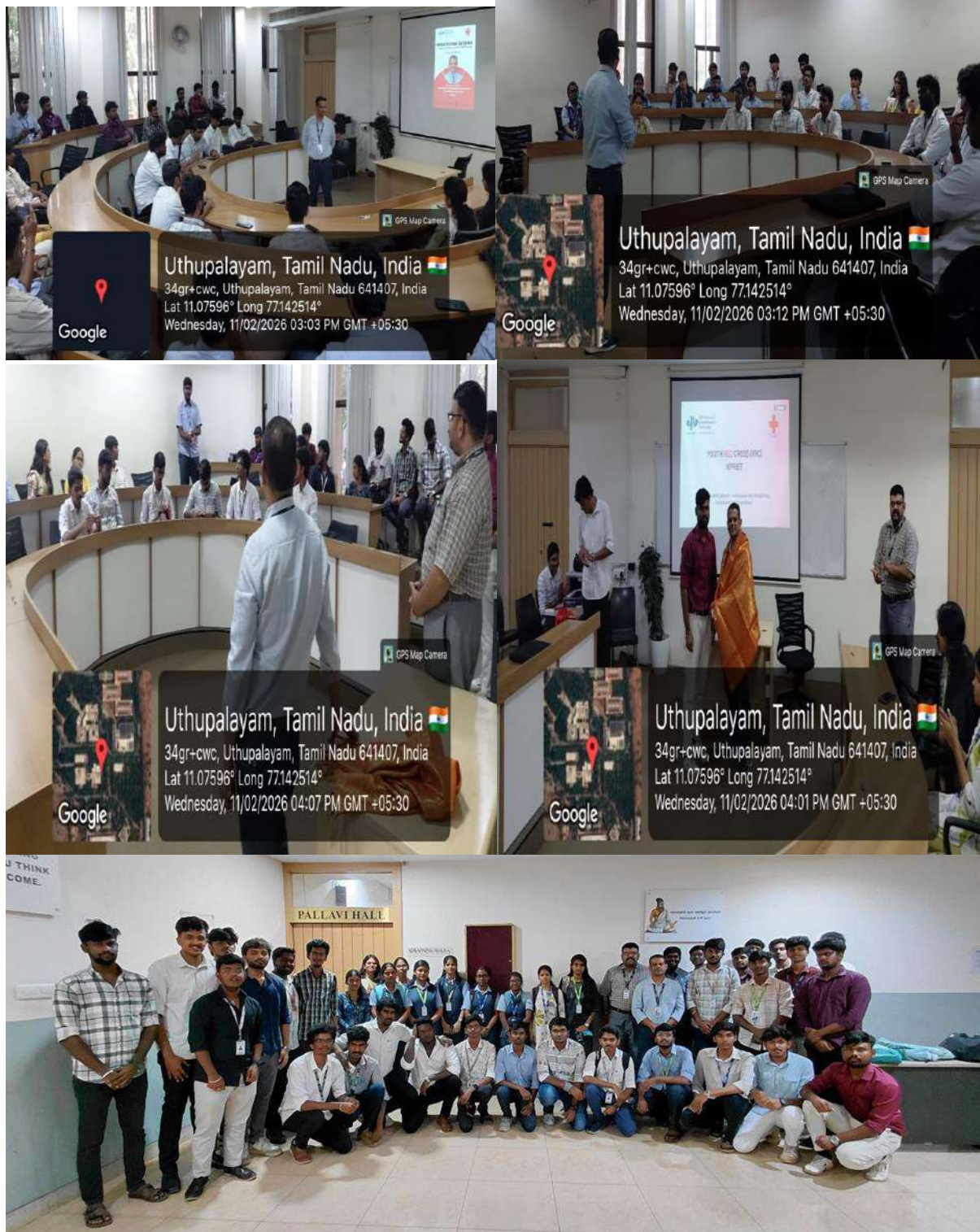
