TEAM A:



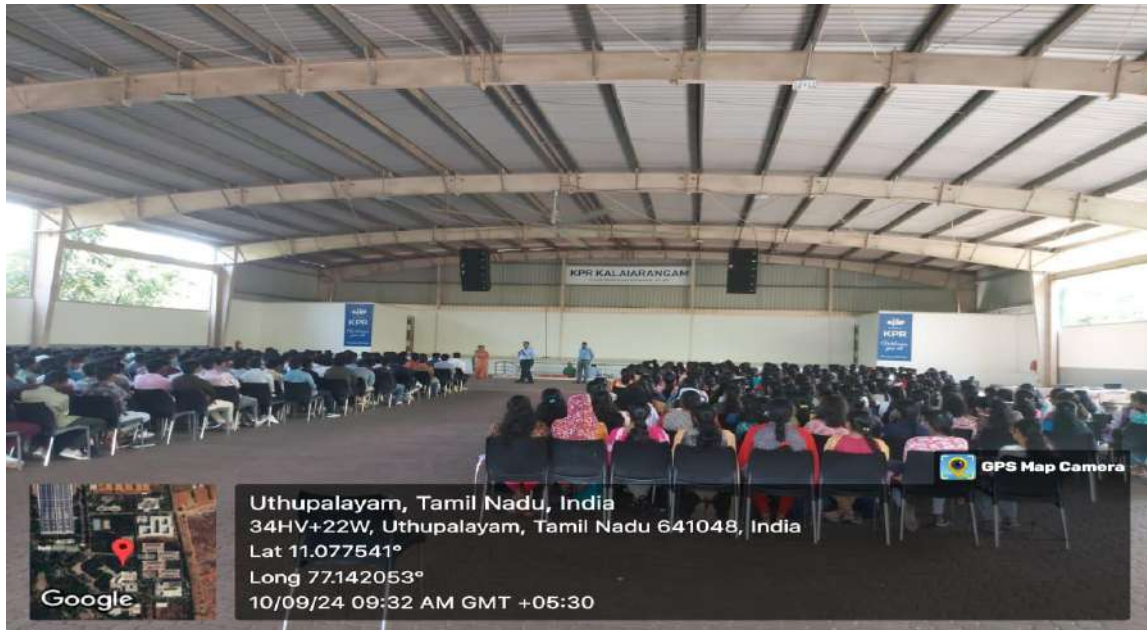

TEAM A:



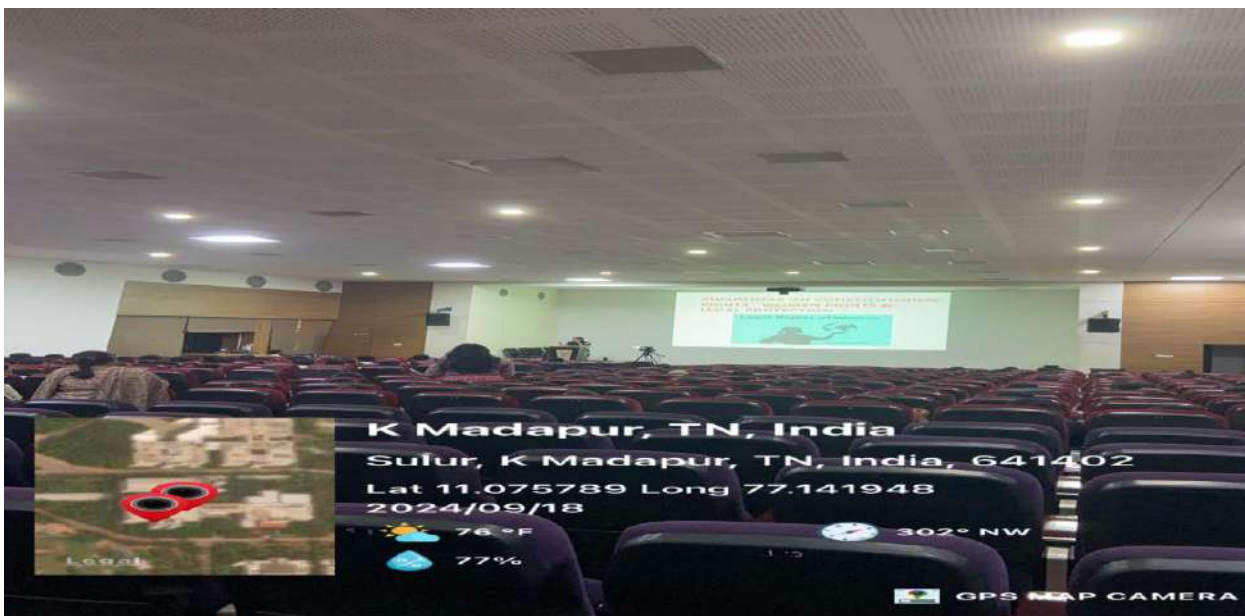
Team A's day started with some insightful knowledge about the Importance of Science & Engineering, which was addressed by the Director of RSC.
