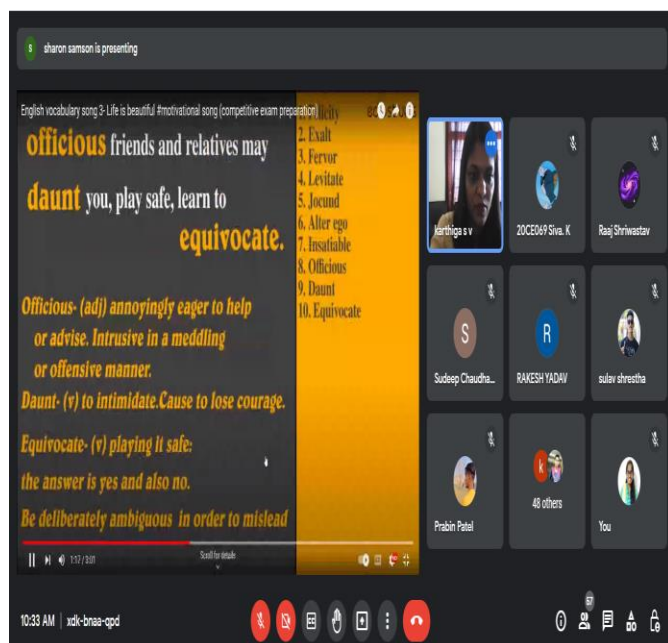


#### IV. Events organized:

celebrated National Mathematics Day

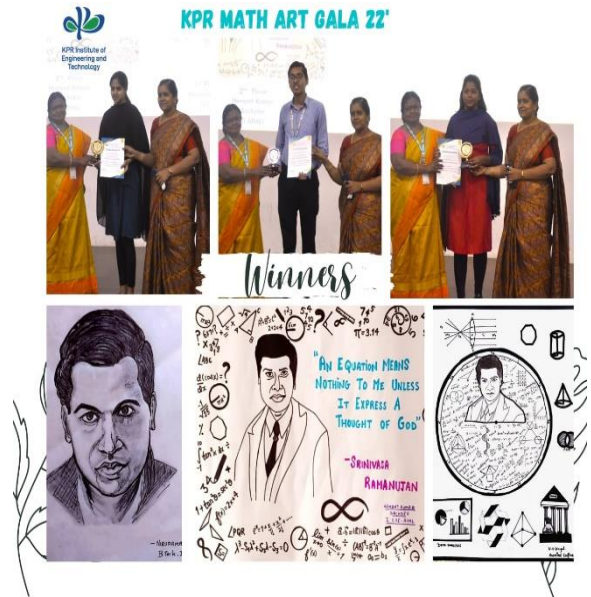
on 22.12.2022. Dr. P. Geetha delivered the

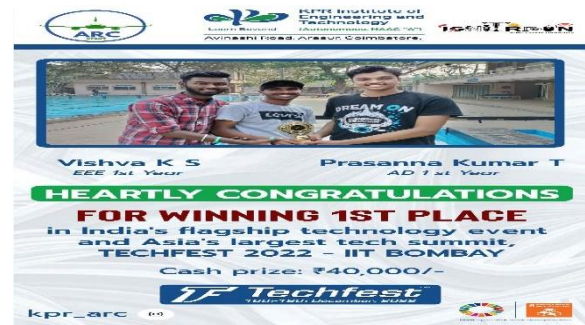
