

STUDENTS DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES EFFECTIVE FROM AY 2021 – 2022

I. Overall Best Outgoing student of UG Programmes (Male and Female)

From the outgoing batch of UG programmes, one boy and one girl student will be selected based on their overall performance (Curricular, Co-curricular and Extracurricular) during their course of study and shall be adjudged as Overall Best outgoing student and shall be awarded **1 Sovereign Gold coin each** with a citation.

II. Best outgoing student in each programme (Male or female)

From the outgoing batch of UG programmes, one student from each programme will be selected based on their overall performance (Curricular, Co-curricular and Extracurricular) during their course of study and shall be adjudged as Best outgoing student of the programme and shall be awarded **Rs.10,000/-** with a citation

III. Best outgoing student project in each programme

From the outgoing batch of UG programmes, one best project will be selected based on the novelty, addressing societal issues, eco-friendliness etc., and shall be awarded **Rs.10,000/-** with a citation

IV. Overall Best sports person (Male and Female)

One boy and one girl student from any year of study will be selected based on their overall performance (Individual / Team events) and shall be adjudged as Overall Best sports person and shall be awarded **Rs.10,000/-each** with a citation

V. Overall Best student in co-curricular activities (Male / female)

One student from any year of study will be selected based on outstanding performance in Paper and Project presentations inside and outside the college, NPTEL certification, participation in Hackathon, internships, product development etc., The selected student shall be awarded **Rs.15,000/-** with a citation

VI. Overall Best student in extracurricular activities (Male / female)

One student from any year of study will be selected based on outstanding performance in extra curricular events and he/she must have represented the college in various forums. The involvement in Sports, Cultural and Club activities etc., will be considered. The selected student shall be awarded **Rs.15,000/-** with a citation

VII. Best student volunteer in Social / Community Service in each programme (Male / female)

One student from any year of study in each programme will be selected based on the social service, blood donation, helping needy people at orphanages and elderly homes, being empathetic etc., The student shall be awarded **Rs.2,000/-** with a citation

VIII. Best Student in First year in each programme (Male / female)

One student from each programme will be selected based on their overall performance (Curricular, Co-curricular and Extracurricular) and shall be adjudged as Best student in first year of the respective discipline and shall be awarded **Rs.5,000/-** with a citation

IX. Scholarship scheme for meritorious students studying in second, third and final year Classes

In each branch of study, based on the academic and overall performance of the students, scholarships will be given during every academic year to motivate them to perform well in the subsequent years. The first and second top academic performers in each year will be given a scholarship of **Rs. 5,000/- and Rs. 3,000/-** respectively and this amount will be adjusted in their Tuition fee.

X. Awards for Achievements in Games (Male / female)

During the course of study, if any student team represents the institution at the Zonal and Interzonal levels, an incentive will be awarded.

- ❖ **Interzonal level (winners) - Rs 1,500/- per player**
- ❖ **Zonal level (winners) - Rs 750/- per player**

XI. Awards for Achievements in Sports(Male / female)

During the course of study, if any student represents the institution at the World University, Inter university, Interzonal and zonal levels, an incentive will be awarded.

- ❖ **World university representation - Rs 25,000/-**
- ❖ **Inter university representaion - Rs 10,000/-**
- ❖ **State meet representation - Rs 2,000/-**
- ❖ **Interzonal level winner - Rs 2,000/-**
- ❖ **Zonal level winner - Rs 1,000/-**

XII. Awards for Achievements in Technical Events (Male / female)

This is awarded to the students to encourage and motivate them to participate in the technical events at International / National (Universities / Deemed universities like IITs, NITs, Anna university, SRM etc..) / TIER I / TIER II institutions. For the students who have won the First / Second place in the technical events / project expo / paper presentation / hackathon / coding contest etc, the prize money will be given as follows:

❖ International Level	Rs 25,000/-	12,500/-
❖ University/Deemed university	Rs 5,000/-	3,000/-
❖ TIER I	Rs 2,500/-	1,500/-
❖ TIER II	Rs 1,000/-	500/-

NOTE:

If a student team comprising more than one student has won the place in the same category, then the prize money will be equally divided and awarded to the team members. The Head of the institution shall make final decision regarding the grant of TA / DA expenses for international and university levels.

XIII. Seed Money for Projects, Start up

In order to encourage the research and entrepreneurship culture among the budding engineering graduates, the following scheme is made available by KPRIET for its students.

- ❖ Seed money will be sanctioned to the student(s) to pursue research work either individually or in association with fellow student community inclusive of inter disciplinary group.
- ❖ Interested students can submit their detailed project proposals. The proposals will be scrutinized by a committee of experts. This committee will meet once in TWO months. Experts will assess and evaluate the novelty, technical feasibility, commercial viability, future scope and benefits to the society, etc. Based on the recommendations of the expert committee the quantum of seed money and time schedule will be finalized.

- ❖ Seed money can be utilized towards the procurement of components / materials, hardware fabrication, material synthesizing and integration. However, labor, fabrication and consultancy charges will not be admissible. Seed Money shall not be utilized for purchase of computers / accessories or for any office related equipment and furniture.

Adhering of safety regulations and other guidelines regarding the testing / disposal, as prescribed by the relevant Government rules are mandatory and is the sole responsibility of the student(s). Institute will not be responsible for any loss / deviations during the course of research work or the execution of the project. The faculty coordinator shall disseminate the necessary guidelines in this regard and ensure that they are followed scrupulously.

- ❖ Student(s) should utilize the sanctioned amount effectively and present their progress of work periodically as decided by the Principal. The work shall be presented in competitions at regional, national and international levels. Based on the level of these competitions and the awards won, additional incentives / allowances may be provided subject to the conditions and case to case basis.
- ❖ Seed money proposals with the complete schedule of execution / repayment / recovery by the student(s) / for startups will be considered as per the expert committee recommendations. Necessary infrastructural and students' manpower support will be extended depending on the nature of the work carried out by the startups.
- ❖ The outcomes in terms of publications, patents, awards will be acknowledged and will remain in joint ownership of the student(s) and KPRIET. In case of commercialization of end product, the revenue sharing basis will be decided by the management of KPRIET which will be final.
