The following Suggestions were made by the members of the Governing Body

- Approval from MHRD shall be taken before starting any Foreign University Collaboration. While choosing the collaborating University collegeshall choose from the top 200 QS ranked institutions.
- Members expressed happiness about the different research incentive Schemes and the introduction of Liberal Arts Programs.
- A clear institutional Road Map for the next 10 Years shall be made and placed before the next Governing Body meeting.

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- 4. The staff selection committee shall have one permanent member from the Governing Body
- Value addition to students through change of Curriculum and Pedagogy shall be done using the Autonomous status in the next 5 to 10 years in order to a create basic strength and build brand value before becoming a University.
- 6. The term "Flexible Assessment" shall be changed to "Various Assessment Techniques". These Techniques should be clear, transparent and give equal opportunity to all the students. The CoE should have the details of the techniques and monitor the departments regarding the usage of these techniques.
- 7. The faculty retention was found to be low due to social reasons like Wedding etc
- In breeding of faculty members shall be avoided.
- 9. Citation index values shall be indicated in future presentations.
- 10. Faculty members who get sanctions / approvals for special Laboratory and centers shall be given important positions in the respective Laboratory / centers.
- 11. While starting AI & DS program, the college should collaborate with big companies and get a high brand value.
- 12. A sum of Rs. 20lakhs shall be set apart for Autonomy related activities.
- 13. Innovation and incubation centers on the model ofthe Research Park in IIT Chennal shall be setup in future. Value addition to the college through Patents & papers shall be improved.
- 14. Various Green Initiatives taken up by the college viz. Tree Plantation, Solar Power, Rain Water Harvesting, Bio-Gas, and STPwere explained to the members.
- 15. Centre for Pollution Control and Environmental Engineering, Puducherry shall be approached for carrying out overall Mass Balance and Energy Balance and arrive at profitable methods of energy conservation.
- 16. For branches like Civil, Mechanical, EEE and ECE, placement shall be ensured in core companies.
- 17.One department shall be identified or develop into a department of national importance. Interaction with higher level Institutions like PSG, Anna University, Bharathiar University shall be increased which will result in improvement of research activities.

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- 18. Faculty being the most important component, the institution shall ensure retention of acore team (50 to 60 % Faculty) for a longer period.
- 19. Principal informed that the budget for the Academic year 2020 21 will be circulated to the members for perusal and approval.

The Principal thanked all the members for their valuable suggestions and inputs which will help the institution to march ahead.

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
